ENGL 1301 Library Project

1. Using the Library Catalog~

- a. Find a book that is available at your library written *by* your assigned author. Print the full details page in the library catalog and use this information to cite the book using MLA documentation form. Label the page as Item 1A.
- b. Find a book available at your library written, all or in part, *about* your assigned author or their works. Print the full details screen in the library catalog and use this information to cite the book using MLA documentation form. Label the page as Item 1B. Submit both Item 1A and 1B with your project. Note: If you choose an e-book, additional access information is required in the citation. Use examples on “Citing the 1301 Project” as a guide.

2. Using Periodical Resources ~ Scholarly Journals

Use an online periodical database of magazine and scholarly journal articles to find at least three references for articles from *scholarly literary journals* about some aspect of your author’s life or works. Identify three references to articles that are fully *available in your library* either in print or online. Print three of these references, and label the page as Item 2 for submission with your project. These three references will be used to complete the next item in the project.

3. Printing a full article in PDF ~

Using the reference information from Item 2, open *ONE* of the three articles in *PDF full-image* form (it will look exactly like the page in the print journal.) Print the first page only of the article. Label this page as Item 3, and submit it with your project. Cite the article using MLA documentation form including the database name, database company name, library, date of access and URL.

4. Using Periodical Resources ~ Newspapers

Use a newspaper database to find a recent newspaper article about a *controversial topic* that interests you. Print the first page only of the article in HTML full-text form and label it as Item 4. Cite the article in MLA documentation form, including database name, etc. as in #3.

5. Using Periodical Resources ~ Weekly News Magazines

Staying with the same research topic as Item 4, use a general periodical database to find an article published in one of these weekly news magazines: *Time*, *Newsweek*, *U.S. News and World Report*, *Macleans* or *The Economist*. Print the first page only of the full article in HTML full-text form. Label it Item 5. Cite the article in MLA documentation form (as in #3 & 4)

Your completed project will be turned in with all printed pages attached to this page along with the page of MLA citations created using word software.
